



Our Fees for Motoring Offences

In the majority of cases we will be able to help you with your traffic offence case for a fixed fee plus our travelling expenses to court charged at 45 per mile.

Guilty Plea

Our fee for a guilty plea to a traffic offence in the Magistrates Court ranges from £350 to £500 plus VAT. The actual fee depends upon the complexity of your case and will be agreed before you have to decide whether to instruct us or not.

- In straightforward cases our fee will be £350 plus VAT plus traveling expenses.
- In more complex cases our fee will be £500 plus VAT plus traveling expenses.

Not Guilty Plea

Our fees for trial for a traffic offence is determined by how complex the case is and how long the trial is expected to take. This can depend upon how many witnesses are to be called or how many charges are to be considered by the court.

For a noncomplex trial lasting no more than 90 minutes our fee is £500 plus VAT plus travelling expenses.

For a trial that last up to half a day our fee is £750 plus VAT plus travelling expenses.

If the trial last for more than half a day our fee is £1,000 plus VAT plus traveling expenses.

Our Fees Include:

- Considering the evidence provided by the relevant prosecuting authority.
- Taking your instructions.
- Providing advice in relation to plea and likely sentence.
- Advice on the options available to the court in relation to sentencing.
- Where appropriate, advice on whether an exceptional hardship, or special reasons argument should be made.
- Advice and Representation at a single hearing in the Magistrates Court.

Our Fees do not Include

- Instruction of any expert witnesses.
- Taking statements from any witnesses.
- Advice or assistance in relation to any appeal.
